

On the session held on February 6th 2020 the .hr Domain Management Committee, based upon the Article 4, Item 1 of the Ordinance on the Organisation and Management of the National Top-level Domain (furtheron as "the Ordinance") has brought the following

DECISION AMENDMENT

1. In Decision brought on February 3rd 2014 related to the rights of the legal entities with business establishment in EU, the Item 1 is to be altered as follows:

"By way of derogation from the Article 15, Item 4 of the Ordinance, the legal entities with the business establishment in one of the Member States of the European Union, United Kingdom of Great Britain and Northern Ireland, do not need to have a registered office, branch office or any other permanent organizational form in Republic of Croatia in order to register a second-level domain."

2. Item 2. to be deleted.

Explanation

Taking into consideration that, on the January 29th 2020, the European Parliament has confirmed withdrawal of the United Kingdom of Great Britain and Northern Ireland from the European Union, effective on the date of January 31st 2020, it has been decided as stated.
